About the area ...

Half an hour's easy drive from the channel port of Cherbourg, you will find yourself in the lush green countryside of the Saire valley.

The Saire meets the sea near Saint-Vaast-La-Hougue, a charming fishing port. Morsalines lies just around the bay, 3 km south of the market town of Quettehou. From the garden at Hameau Beauvais you can look out over Saint-Vaast and the bay of La Hougue. The sea is less than 10 minutes' gentle walk away.

About the house ...

No.8 used to be two cottages. On the ground floor there is a large, fully equipped kitchen-diner (with fridge/freezer, washing machine and dishwasher), and a large, comfortable sitting room (with double sofa-bed).

Plenty of space . . .

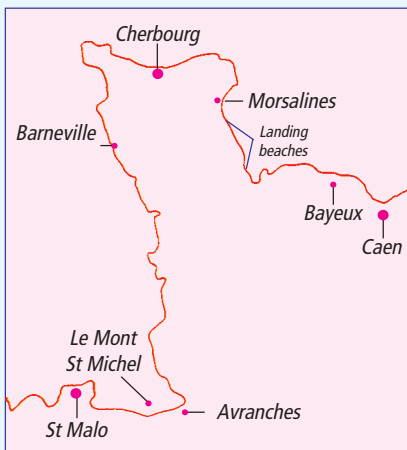
